

# How do you decide what sites are allocated?

- A 'Call for Sites' happens where the Council asks for land to come forward to form part of the Local Plan
- Across the borough we have had over 600 potential sites come forward for review. These sites are then assessed against nationally set criteria to determine the most likely to be suitable e.g. 'Grey belt' criteria.
- In the Draft Local Plan there are 95 residential or mixed-use proposed allocations
- Brownfield sites in sustainable locations are prioritised – though there are not enough to meet the Government-set need
- These sites are then presented for consultation. **We are at this stage at the moment**
